

On Wednesday in Week 10, Year One held a liturgy with our parents. Our theme was Lent. We talked about how during Lent we grow and change to get



#### Sudoku

and observed 6 Yellow completing a kids Sudoku puzzle. This puzzle involved players inserting numbers into a grid whereby certain rules had to be followed in such a way that every number appeared once in each row, column, and region. Mr Mills decided to connect 4 tables together and then use masking tape to create a Sudoku grid using 16 squares on the tables. After we had

to tell the Lord. It is repenting and thinking about how to improve.


