Dear Parents of current Kindergarten to Year Five 2018

your code is; 3q2n5

A letter was sent home with each student in their report envelopes notifying you of the new code to enter to book your child/children in for Maths interviews on Wednesday, 30th January. It is vital that you put your child into next year's grades interviews - some interviews have been booked incorrectly for the beginning of this year. Therefore, if your child is currently in Kindergarten you must book Year 1, 2019, if your child is in Year 1 this year then you must book Year 2, 2019 etc. Do not worry about the class colour; book your child into the 1/2 hour time slot that suits you. If the interviews are fully booked for that grade, please do not worry as the students will be tested on return to school in 2019.

Leaving

If you know your child/ren will not be returning to this school in 2019, please let the office know as soon as possible, in writing. It is a CEDP Policy that 10 school weeks notice is given to the principal before the removal of your child from the school, otherwise a full term fees will be required to be paid.

Change of Details

If you have moved house or changed your contact details, please notify the school office as soon as possible to update your details in case of an emergency.

Student's Classes

It is a school policy that the make up of classes are revised at the end of Kindergarten (Early Stage One), Year Two (End of Stage One), Year Four (End of Stage Two) and as needed in other years. It must be remembered that the structure of our school facilitates a number of students working with a number of teachers. The decision of movement of students is at the discretion of the Principal.




